**Education Week Celebrations**

On arrival, please use the school visitor check in QR codes located outside the hall. Two students from each class will be presented a special award based on their academic progress, conduct and effort. There will be performances from the drumming group, school choir and dance group.

**9:55 – 10:20 am Mathematics Parent Workshops**

Parents and carers are invited to attend Mathematics workshops and will provide parents with strategies and simple games parents can play with their child. Workshops will be presented in different rooms depending on the stage. Parents can choose which workshop they would like to attend if they have more than one child at the school.

- Stage 1- Library
- Stage 2 – Classroom under the library (3/4M and 5/6V classroom)
- Stage 3 – 5/6 T and 5/6C classroom

### **10:25 – 11am Open Classroom Visits**

Students will share with parents and carers Mathematics learning activities related to the parent education workshop. If you have more than one child at the school, you can visit both classrooms.

Education Day will conclude at 11 am and there will be **no early sign outs on the day.**
