The Jamberoo Recreation Park Excursion has a variety of water slides, wave pool and other activities such as mini golf. Students are not allowed to go on the toboggan or chairlift.

All students who have indicated they are a **swimmer** will be required to participate in a swimming test at Jamberoo Recreation Park before they are allowed in the water. The purpose is to identify your child's swimming proficiency.

At the completion of the swimming test your child will be issued with either:

- Blue wrist band students capable of swimming 25 metres in a recognisable stroke and can float.
- Yellow wrist band students who are not capable of swimming 25 metres in a recognisable stroke unassisted and have limited floating ability.

If your child receives a yellow wrist band or they are identified as a non-swimmer and he/she will not be able to participate in deep water activities and will require teacher supervision. If you have any further questions, please see Mr Thompson.

**Please note:** Non – swimmers will only be allowed in shallow water (waist deep). Swimmers will be allowed in deep water.
